



Regulations market and tasting ALP' - Stans

1. EXHIBITOR / PRODUCT

References to persons apply equally to women and men.

- The event is open to producers of regional products based in Switzerland and the Alpine countries (Germany, France, Liechtenstein, Austria, Italy and Slovenia) who present their own products.
- Only the sale and tasting of food is permitted.
- The products can be offered for tasting and/or sale.
- Products that are offered for sale must also be offered for tasting.
- **The sale of meals is prohibited.**
- The market takes place over two days. Exhibitors undertake to be present on both days.

2. COSTS OF PARTICIPATION

- Indoor / outdoor stand **CHF 50.– / day**
Without electricity and running water. The exhibitor is responsible for requesting access to electricity or water if needed.

3. CONFIRMATION OF REGISTRATION

- Registration takes place exclusively online on the website www.alp26.ch until **18 August 2026**
- Registration is valid after written confirmation from the ALP' organisation.
- After completing the registration, the exhibitor will receive a written confirmation with a stand number and an organisational plan.
- Confirmation of registration implies acceptance of these regulations.
- Neither a stand nor a location will be allocated without confirmation from the organiser.
- The organiser reserves the right to accept or reject applications, to limit the number of exhibitors and to exclude exhibitors who do not comply with these regulations.
- **If an exhibitor fails to attend the event, the costs of CHF 250 will be invoiced.**

4. MARKET STALL AND MATERIAL

- Each exhibitor is allocated a standard area of 5 m² (2.5 x 2m).
- One market table (1x2m) per exhibitor will be provided in this area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for additional exhibition material (table, chairs, cooling bench, etc.).
- Any advertising that does not relate to the products offered is subject to authorisation.
- There is no running water.

5. ADVERTISING

- Every exhibitor is encouraged to promote the event as far as possible.
- The organiser will provide him with flyers for this purpose.

6. LOCATION

- Each exhibitor must accept the location allocated to him.
- Stands are planned indoors and possibly outdoors.

7. MARKET OPENING HOURS

- Saturday, 7 November 2026, 10:00 h to 17:00 h
- Sunday, 8 November 2026, 9:00 h to 17:00 h

8. ASSEMBLY AND DISMANTLING

- The stands will be set up on Friday 6 November 2026 from 16:00 h to 20:00 h and on Saturday 7 November 2026 from 07:00 h to 9:30 h.
- Access to the stands with vehicles is possible **on Friday from 16:00 h to 20:00 h and on Saturday from 7:00 h to 9:30 h and from 17:30 h to 19:00 h as well as on Sunday from 7:00 h to 9:30 h.**
- Each stand will be assigned a specific arrival and departure time, as unloading space is very limited.
- Dismantling of the stands is possible **on Sunday from 17:30 h.**

9. CAR PARK

- A special car park is available to exhibitors free of charge.

10. INSURANCE AND THEFT

- The organiser accepts no liability for accidents. Exhibitors must have liability insurance with a supplement.
- The organiser accepts no liability for theft or damage.
